5 Group II (Psychobio & Neuroscience): Any PSYC course in the 2400s, 3400s, 4400s. Also UN1010.

6 Group III (Social, Personality, & Abnormal): Any 2600s, 3600s, or 4600s.

7 One course meeting the seminar requirement: Must be taken for at least 3 points.
