① **Science of Psychology:** UN1001, S1001, or BC1001.

④ **Group I (Perception & Cognition):** Any PSYC course in the 2200s, 3200s, or 4200s. Also UN1420.

⑤ **Group II (Psychobio & Neuroscience):** Any PSYC course in the 2400s, 3400s, 4400s. Also UN1010*.

⑥ **Group III (Social, Personality, & Abnormal):** Any 2600s, 3600s, or 4600s. Also UN1450 or UN1455.

⑦ **One course meeting the seminar requirement:** Must be taken for at least 3 points.

⊙ **Other ("elective") courses:** May include up to 8 points of UN3950.

Barnard psych courses: Up to 9 Barnard points may be applied as elective credit without DUS approval. Transfer credit: Psych courses taken at other institutions require DUS approval and a grade of B- or better in order to count toward the major. No more than 9 transfer credits (including any Barnard points) may be applied toward the major.
