## **Overlapping Courses**

Credit toward the major will not be given for any course that overlaps significantly the content of a course previously taken. For instance, you will not receive credit for two courses—one at Columbia and one at Barnard—whose content largely overlaps. The following table identifies a number of such courses.

The fact that two courses overlap does not mean that they are equivalent in content, or that they may be applied to the same major requirements. If you wish to use Barnard courses toward a psychology major requirement please refer to the table of <u>Barnard Courses Approved for the Psychology Major</u>.
