

Overlapping Courses

Credit toward the major will not be given for any course that overlaps significantly the content of a course previously taken. For instance, you will not receive credit for two courses—one at Columbia and one at Barnard—whose content largely overlaps. The following table identifies a number of such courses.

The fact that two courses overlap does not mean that they are equivalent in content, or that they may be applied to the same major requirements.
