Commitment Requirements:

 - Fall 2024 positions require <u>5-10 hours per week</u> with a minimum of <u>four on-site hours</u> <u>on Monday.</u> The remaining hours will be hybrid.
 - Classroom observations and intervention implementation will occur on Mondays. To be considered for this position you must have Monday availability.
